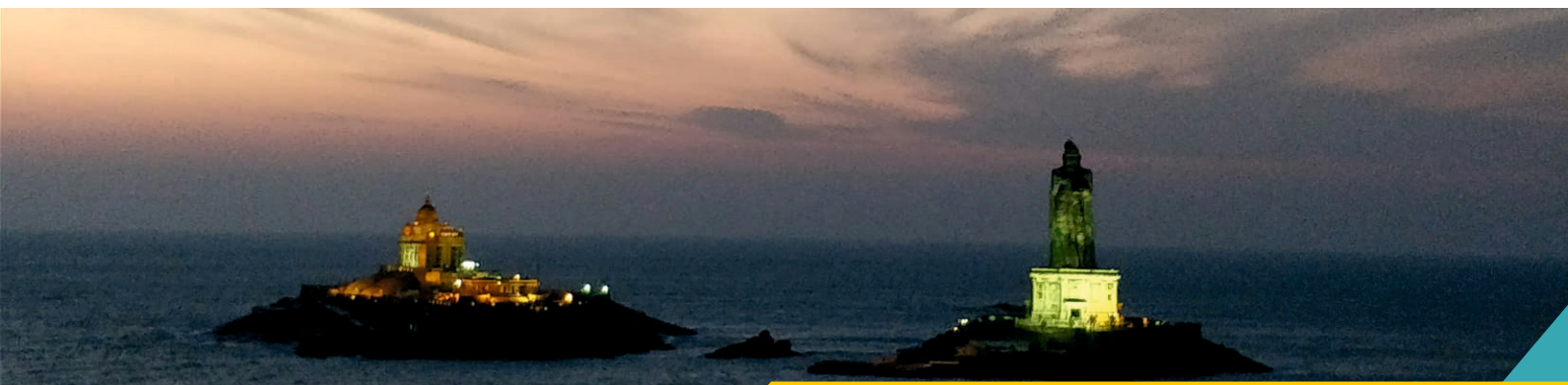

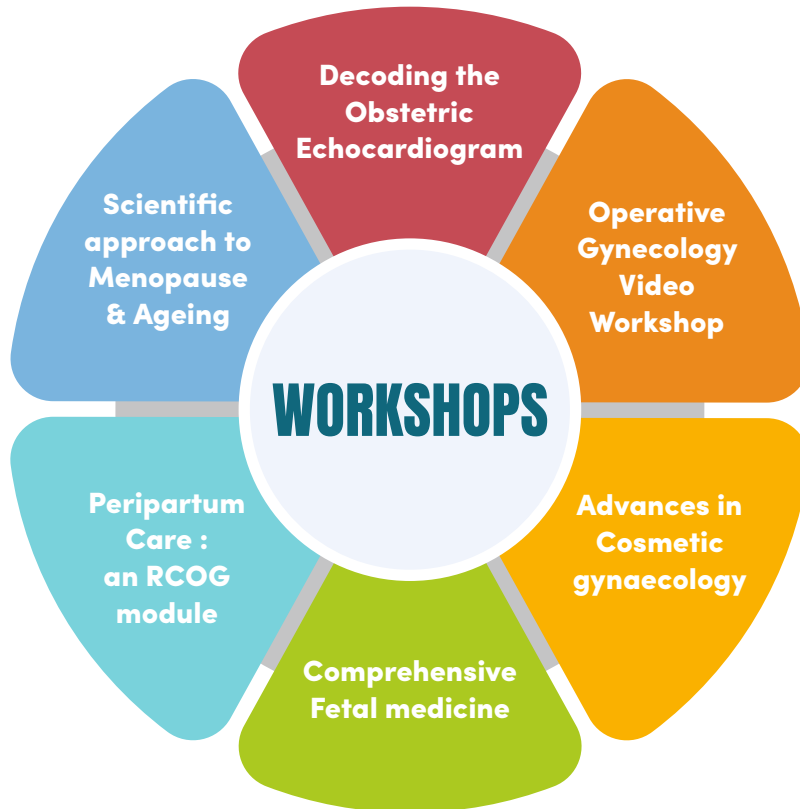

HOST CITY **KANYAKUMARI**

Kanyakumari The Virgin (or Kanya) Princess' referring to Devi Kanya Kumari officially known as Kanyakumari, formerly known as Cape Comorin) is a city in Kanyakumari district in the state of Tamil Nadu, India. It is the southernmost tip of the Indian subcontinent and the southernmost city in mainland India, and thus referred to as "**The Land's End**". The city is situated 90 kilometres (56 mi) south of Thiruvananthapuram city, and about 20 kilometres (12 mi) south of Nagercoil, the headquarters of Kanyakumari district. It is the southernmost tip of mainland India. Kanyakumari is popular for its beautiful beaches, unique Vivekananda Rock Memorial, and stunning sunrise and sunset views. It is also a major pilgrimage centre for Hindus.



PLACES TO VISIT IN KANYAKUMARI



Vivekananda Rock Memorial

Vivekananda Rock Memorial is a monument and popular tourist attraction in Kanyakumari, India's southernmost tip. The memorial stands on one of the two rocks located about 500 meters off mainland of Vavathurai, Tamil Nadu. It was built in 1970 in honour of Swami Vivekananda, who is said to have attained enlightenment on the rock.

Kanyakumari Beach

Located at the southernmost coast of the Indian peninsula, Kanyakumari Beach offers attractions that are highly unique. Kanyakumari is also the only place on Earth from where you can see the spectacular sights of sunrise and sunset from the very same location.



Thiruvalluvar Statue

The Thiruvalluvar Statue, or the Valluvar Statue, is a 41-metre-tall (133 ft) stone sculpture of the Tamil poet and philosopher Valluvar, known as Thiruvalluvar, the author of the Thirukkural, an ancient Tamil work on Dharma and morality.



Thanumalayan temple - Sthanumalayan Kovil

The Thanumalayan Temple, also called Sthanumalayan Temple, is an important Hindu temple located in Suchindram in the Kanyakumari district of Tamil Nadu, India. The Thanumalayan Temple is of importance to both Shaivaite and Vaishnavite sects of Hinduism, as the name Stanumalaya denotes the Trimurti; "Stanu" means Mahesha; "Mal" means Vishnu; and the "Ayan" means Brahma. It counts among the Abhimana Kshetrams in Vaishnavite traditions.

Padmanabhapuram Palace

Padmanabhapuram Palace, also known as Kalkulam Palace, is a Travancore-era palace located in Padmanabhapuram in the Kanyakumari district of the Indian state of Tamil Nadu. The palace is owned, controlled and maintained by kerala government. Padmanabhapuram is the former capital city of



Mathoor Aqueduct

Mathoor Aqueduct was constructed in 1966 as a drought relief measure over the river Pahralli to carry water for irrigation from an elevated level of one hill to another. Basically built as an aqueduct to transport water for irrigation purposes, Mathoor Hanging Bridge is the tallest and longest trough bridge in Asia. It is 115 ft in height and 1 km long.

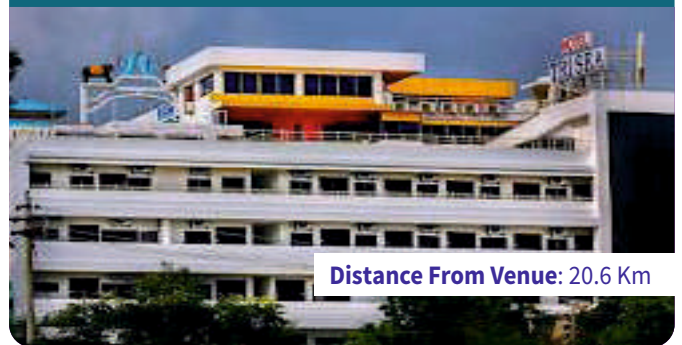
